The Personalized Learning Pathway

(PLP) is a new online platform that helps stu-



dents navigate their path to academic and career success. The PLP helps students: keep track of achievements, goals, see their performance on assessments and

access targeted lessons to improve; track progress toward graduation and discover areas they may need to address. Students can keep track of advanced coursework, industry certifications and performance on college entrance exams to determine if they are ready for college and careers, and more. Students can access the PLP through clever.com/in/pcsb by signing in with their PCS email account.
