Pinellas County Schools will continue with digital instruction for the rest of the 2019-20 school year. Governor DeSantis and the Department of Education extended the closure of all school buildings in the state of Florida for the balance of the school year due to the COVID-19 health crisis.

Pinellas County Schools (PCS) Meal Distribution

PCS will start distributing meals for six days beginning on Wednesday, April 22 through the end of the school year. Once a week, families will receive a combination of hot and cold breakfast items and hot lunch entrees, with easy heating instructions. Parents are asked to pop open their trunks at the sites for safe food delivery. Families who walk to the site can bring a bag or large box.

Wednesday, April 22 – 6 days-worth of meals Wednesday, April 29 – 6 days-worth of meals Wednesday, May 6 – 6 days-worth of meals Wednesday, May 13 – 6 days-worth of meals Wednesday, May 20 – 6 days-worth of meals Wednesday, May 27 – 6 days-worth of meals

Attendance in the Digital Classroom in Microsoft Teams: The attendance in the

digital classroom is important and is mandatory every day, just like in a regular school setting. Please check with your teachers about their attendance procedure in the digital classroom.

Assignments in the Digital Classroom in Microsoft Teams:

Teachers are assigning work and quizzes in Microsoft Teams. Make sure to complete all your assignments by due date or, if needed, request extra time from your teacher. When completing an assignment in Microsoft Teams, make sure to click on "Turn in" tab so your teacher can see it.



Attendance and Grades in

Focus: Please check your child's attendance and grades in FOCUS. Here is where teachers are posting

the attendance and the assignments grades. For questions or concerns about your child's attendance, grades and/or progress, please connect with your child's teachers as soon as possible for support.

4. Bilingual Support in Schools:

Most schools have bilingual assistants available every day to help you and your child. If your child needs bilingual assistance, please contact the bilingual assistant or the Spanish Helpline at 588 6415.

5. How to connect with your child's teacher(s) for assistance:

If you know the email address of your child's teachers, you can email each teacher individually for support. Otherwise, visit your child's school website and follow these steps:

1. Look at the top of the page and click where it says, "About US".

2. Then, click on " Staff/Staff Directory " and look for the name of your child's teacher.

3. Click on the teacher's name to send an email.
