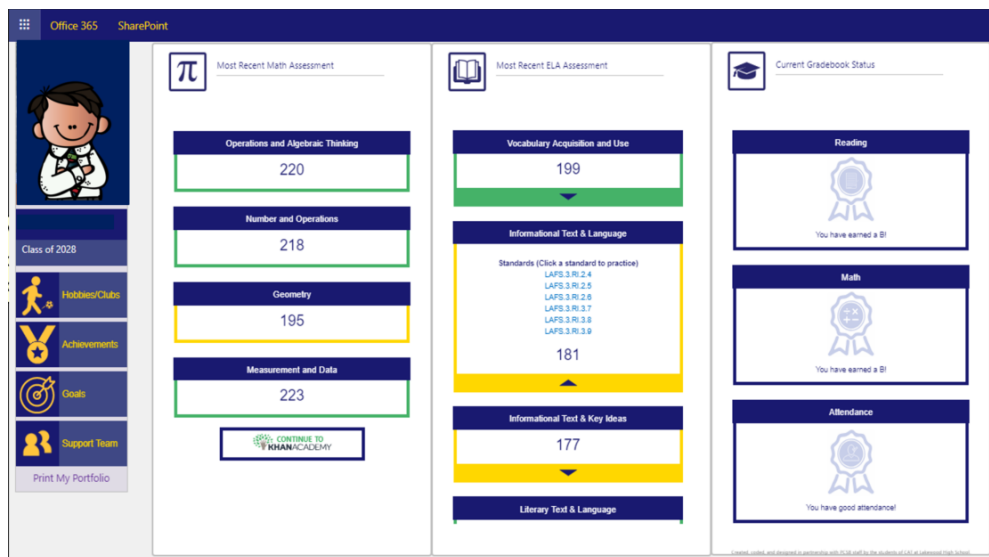

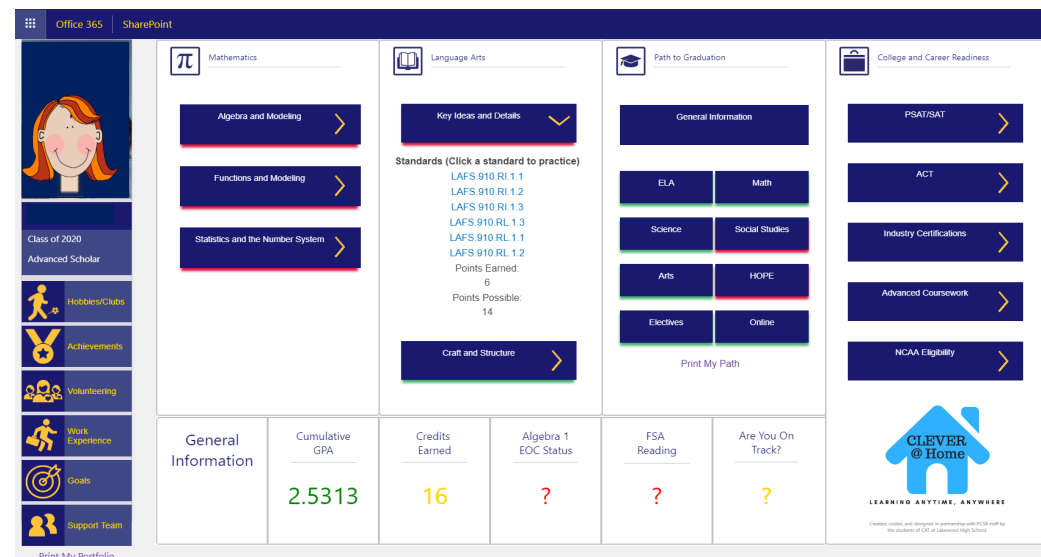


WHAT IS PERSONALIZED LEARNING PATHWAY (PLP)?

The Personalized Learning Pathway (PLP) is a learning application that uses students' performance information to **assign students with personalized lessons based on their academic progress in the school and on state/district assessments**. Students in grades 3-12 can access online lessons for the areas in which they need to work most for their academic success.

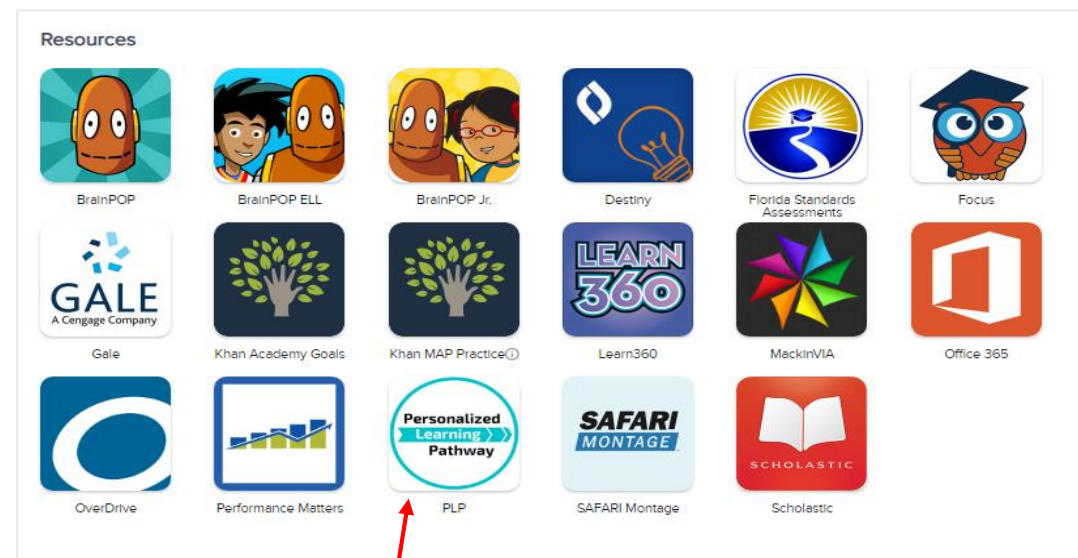
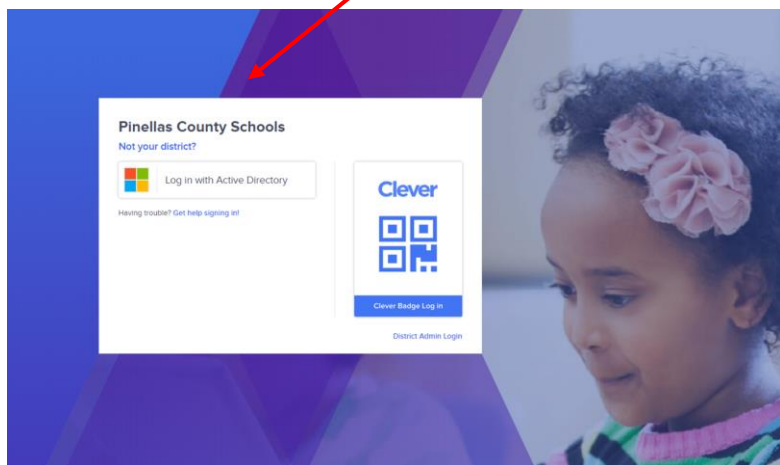




HOW TO ACCESS THE PERSONALIZED LEARNING PATHWAY (PLP)?




To Access the Personalized Learning Pathway students log into **Clever at Home** through the link: <http://clever.com/in/pcsb> using their username and password PCS.
