School Health Services

We have a school nurse assigned part time. Medications should be taken at home whenever possible. If medications (both prescription and over the counter) are required at school, a medication card must be completed each year.

The medication policy for parents is as follows:

- No medications are to be brought in by students.
- No medication is to be accepted without a medication card filled out in the school clinic or front office, not to be taken home.
- All medicine must be in an unopened box.
- All medication must be counted with parent and a • staff member.
- Any medical treatments or scripted medication or over the counter must have a Doctors order to accompany it.

Dress Code

Bear Creek is a uniform school. This policy can be found in the front of your child's agenda book. Please purchase appropriate clothing. Please remember:

- * Pants and shorts are to be regular uniform clothing of khaki or navy. No Cargo style! Capri pants, skorts, dresses, skirts for girls are allowed.

DID YOU KNOW?????

Absenteeism in preschool and kindergarten can influence whether a child will be held back in third grade. Several studies document a link between chronic absence — missing 10 percent of the school year — in the early grades and a child's ability to master reading by the end of third grade. With 14 states (including Florida) now linking third grade promotion to reading performance, chronic absence can undermine the broader efforts to improve literacy.

Absenteeism in kindergarten can also affect whether a child other of develops the skills needed to succeed in school. A recently released study by researcher Michael Gottfried at the University of California, shows the negative impact of chronic absenteeism on both academic performance and social-emotional skills needed to persist and engage in learning.


