

Why is attendance so important?

- Good Attendance Student has missed fewer than 5% of school days (generally less than 4 or 5 days in a semester)
- At-Risk Student has missed between 5% and 10% of school days (generally between 5-9 days in a semester)
- Chronic Absence Student has missed 10% or more of school days (generally 9 days or more in a semester)

Application Period for Choice Programs - Opens in January, 2020

Families can apply for magnet, fundamental and career programs January 8 - 17 at <u>https://reservation.pcsb.org</u>. All parents need to have a focus account login in order to apply for the programs. If you have lost your focus account user name and password, just go into any Pinellas County School and ask for another. Please bring in your ID in order for us to reset your focus account. <u>Ready, Set... Kindergarten</u>

Parents will be able to start the kindergarten registration process for the 2020-2021 School Year on

Tuesday, January 13th, 2020.

All new Kindergarten students must turn 5 years old on or before September 1st, 2020. In order to get started you will need to have a Focus Account to get the registration started and then we will need a Birth Certificate, 2 Proofs of Residency, Physical Exam Certificate and a Florida Certificate of Immunization Please call the front office staff

Pre-K3 and VPK Registration for 2020-2021

Pinellas County Schools is beginning the online application process on January 21st - 31st, 2020, for Prekindergarten for 3 year old children and Voluntary Prekindergarten for 4 year olds.

Parents need to have a <u>Focus Account</u> to be able to apply online. If you do not have one please stop by any Pinellas County School to obtain an user name and password and to received step by step instructions on the application process and what paperwork you will need to register.

Pre-K 3 is for children who will be 3 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2020. For information about Pre-K 3, please read more on the Districts website <u>www.pscb.org</u> or call 727-588-6000 x 2184.

VPK is for children who will be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2020. For more information about VPK, visit <u>www.pcsb.org/vpk</u> or call 727-588-6513.

Parents will also need to log back into the district's Student Reservation System on February 24th - March 6th to accept an invitation for Pre-K 3 and VPK programs.
