Ready, Set... Kindergarten

Kindergarten registration process for the 2019-2020 school year has begun. All new Kindergarten students must turn 5 years old on or before September 1st, 2020. In order to get started you will need to have a Focus Account to get the registration started and

then we will need a Birth Certificate, 2 Proofs of Residency, Physical Exam Certificate and a Florida Certificate of Immunization. Please call the front office staff and they will help you with

any questions at 893-2332.

Pre-K3 and VPK Registration for 2020-2021

Parents will need to log back into the district's Student Reservation System on February 24th - March 6th to accept an invitation for Pre-K 3 and VPK programs. Don't forget to log back into <u>reservation.pcsb.org</u> to check the status of your application and accept an invitation.

If you forgot or misplaced your focus username and password just pull up Student Reservation system and pick the box that says <u>Forgot or need to</u> <u>Change / Reset your password?</u>or stop by any Pinellas County School to reset your password and to receive step by step instructions on the application process and what paperwork you will need to bring in to finish registration.

Pre-K 3 is for children who will be 3 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2020. VPK is for children who will be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2020. February is National Children's Dental Health Month

with poor reading skills and retention in the 3rd grade. By the 6th grade, it is considered as early warning indicator that a student will drop out of high school.


