- Advanced - Students who have successfully completed the previous level course content may enroll in the next level course with visual arts teacher approval.
- Every effort should be made to schedule students into the appropriate level visual arts course.
- It is recommended to offer students Digital Art & Design courses at all middle schools.
- Per Ed Specs, visual arts courses teacher-student ratio is 32 (capacity per period is 35).
- Determine the best course progression plan for students with the visual arts teacher(s).
