If you are unsure if your selection fits the requirements, look it up or email the contact provided.

To keep you accountable for your reading, you will fill out the attached reading log. The brief summaries must be written in complete sentences. There is a minimum of 5 entries that realistically reflect your reading, and each entry requires a parent signature. These requirements are to help you avoid cramming the work, which is not to your benefit. Your reading log will be collected by your teacher on Monday, August 15th, but be ready to discuss the book in the first days of school.
