### **Summer Reading Assignment**

We are looking forward to meeting you in our English I and English I Honors classes this fall. During the 2023-24 school year, you will discuss and analyze a variety of non-fiction and fiction selections with classmates. For that reason, you will read a book of your choice this summer.

#### **Choice Book Instructions:**

Select your own fiction or non-fiction book. It must be a minimum of 200 pages and be appropriate for high school. Books such as *Diary of a Wimpy Kid*, for example, are geared for younger readers and are not appropriate. Choose any genre that you like. Be sure to give yourself enough time to complete the book before school starts in August.

To keep you accountable for your reading, you will print and fill out the attached reading log. The brief summaries must be written in complete sentences. A minimum of five entries will realistically reflect your reading, and each entry requires a parent/guardian signature. Your teacher will collect your reading log August 16<sup>th</sup> but be ready to discuss the book in the first days of school.
