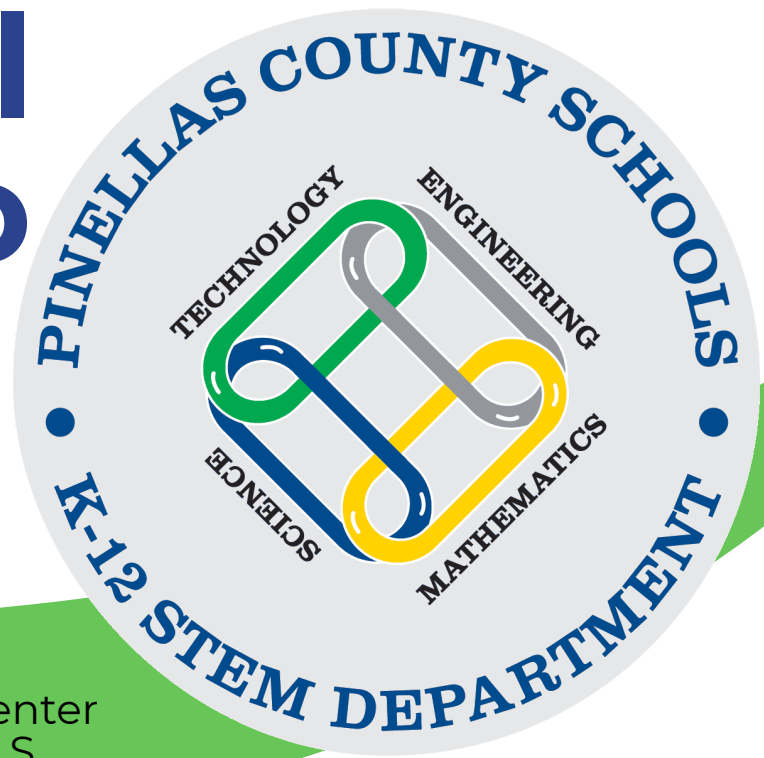


# 6th Annual STEM Expo

- FREE event parking 8am-6pm (see parking details below)
- families can check-in at the USFSP University Student Center welcome table (1st floor)

- all family members are required to wait on the 1st floor while their STEM Academy child will be escorted (by a STEM Academy teacher) to the 2nd floor to get set up for their presentation

## STEM EXPO HAPPENINGS

- 10am-11am: Chris Fischer, OCEARCH Founder and Expedition Leader will be seated at the keynote table for a meet and greet opportunity
- 2nd floor opens and will showcase STEM Academy student projects, student presentations and vendor/display tables
- STEM Outside Activities: use your STEM Expo program booklet (received during check-in at the welcome table) to learn about the STEM activities, times and locations these experiences will occur outside
- after visiting the STEM Expo, wear your expo button (adults & non-STEM Academy students) or expo ribbon (STEM Academy students) to receive 1/2 priced admission to The Dali Museum (only available during expo day 4/27)
- USFSP Reef Cafe and Starbucks (both located on the 1st floor) will be open for lunch & beverage purchases. All proceeds support USFSP (USFSP has generously donated the University Student Center for use with the STEM Expo).

## FREE STEM EXPO PARKING

FREE parking is available from 8am-6pm in the USFSP parking garage (located at the corner of 3rd St. & 5th Ave S., levels 2-5 only) as well as the surrounding parking lots (lots must be identified as Green/Gold). The University Student Center is located directly across from the USFSP parking garage.

- Metered parking surrounding the campus is not free and is the responsibility of the car owner.
- The Dali Museum is within walking distance from the University Student Center. Keep your car parked in the parking garage or the surrounding Green/Gold parking lots while you visit the museum to continue to receive free parking until 6pm.
