I am Mrs. Burns the Behavior Specialist and Restorative Practice Coach. We are a Positive Behavior Intervention Support and Restorative Practicing School taking a Restorative approach to build and develop community within and outside our school. Restorative Practices have several goals which we want to use to build a positive school climate and healthy relationships by taking proactive measures in resolving/managing conflict. We teach students to be involved in positive relationships as they take ownership of their actions, be aware of their own thoughts and feelings and communicate effectively to solve problems. We encourage all stakeholders to be involved.

As we continue to move forward in Virtual Learning it can be challenging to keep students motivated and engaged. We want to avoid power struggles and conflicts instead utilizing conversation questions when responding to challenging behaviors.

At Pinellas Park Elementary (PPE) our students participated in earning Bear Hugs for positive behavior they used to purchase items from the school store and class treasure box as part of the Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS).
