The VISION of Pinellas County Schools Middle Grades STEM programs is to nurture creative thinking in the STEM fields through exploration, inquiry, and collaboration.

The <u>FREE</u> PCS STEM Academy Program offers opportunities to conduct handson STEM investigations, learn the engineering design process, improve team building and leadership skills, explore STEM career pathways and interact with community business partners.

Deadline to apply: Completed applications are due no later than Friday, 10/29/2021

Who is eligible?

All students in grades 6 through 8 are eligible to apply. We look for students who work hard, have an interest in STEM concepts, and will participate for the full 22 weeks. There is no academic performance requirement, however only 25 students can be enrolled into each STEM Academy.

Students *must* complete an application and submit it to the STEM Academy facilitator by Karen Bulino.

Each STEM Academy can accept up to 25 students. If more than 25 students apply, schools will make every effort to add an additional STEM Academy for those students.

What?

During the FREE STEM Academy Program, students will conduct hands-on activities related to STEM concepts (science, technology, engineering and math), explore careers in STEM, complete STEM engineering design projects, and learn from business and community partners. STEM projects completed by students throughout the year will be displayed during the annual STEM Expo which will be held in May 2022 (time and date to be announced soon). Students may also participate in their school or regional science and engineering fair.

When?

This 22-week program will begin during the week of November 1st and will continue through the week ending April 29th. Your child's STEM Academy will meet once per week for 60 minutes before school.

The SMS STEM Academy at your school will be held on Thursday morning from 8-9 a.m. If this date fills, we may add a second session on Wednesday mornings from 8-9 a.m.

The STEM Academy will be held at Seminole Middle School and transportation MUST be provided by the parent/guardian each week. Students should enter through the main office upon arrival.

Cost?

The PCS Middle Grades STEM program offers the STEM Academy Program at your child's school, FREE of charge.

Attendance Requirements

Attendance is a critical component to the success of any program. This is especially true of the middle grades STEM program, which consists of weekly building, coding, completing challenges, and other activities within the engineering design process. Due to overwhelming interest in the STEM Academy Program and the rigor of planned activities, students are expected to attend each session. If a student misses more than 4 *unexcused* sessions, they will be removed from the academy. After 2 unexcused absences, the STEM Academy teacher will send an attendance reminder.

Family Involvement

In May, students enrolled in the STEM Academy Program will receive an invitation to attend and present at the annual FREE STEM Expo that will be held on a Saturday in May. The time, date, and location for this event will be announced soon. This annual event attracts more than 3,200 people every year! More information will be provided to families later in the year.

Please enter information for every area on the application, especially the email section, as this will be used as the main form of communication to receive STEM Academy updates and opportunities.

Deadline to return completed application to school:

No later than Friday, October 29, 2021

Families will be notified of their child's status (accepted or wait list) no later than Monday, November 1, 2021.
