SIG4 Proposal Review Process

Round 1: Checklist of 14 USED Requirements

(2 weeks)

Proceed if threshold is met

Round 2: Program Review by Size Alike

(3 weeks)

All proposals proceed

Round 3: Expert Panel Review

(6 weeks)

Proceed according to rank order within size-alike

Round 4: Interview by Committee

(4 weeks)

Recommendations made to Commissioner



SIG4 Projected Timeline

January 2017 Districts notified of award status

March 1, 2017 – August 31, 2017 = Year 1

September 1, 2017 – August 31, 2018 = Year 2

September 1, 2018 – August 31, 2019 = Year 3

September 1, 2019 – August 31, 2020 = Year 4

September 1, 2020 – August 31, 2021 = Year 5

Timeline: Year 1 and Year 2

Hire Community School Director & Build Partnerships

- ➤ Identify Core Partners Lead Non-Profit, University, Healthcare, and School District
- Establish an Advisory Board
- Create a Shared Implementation Plan/Organizational Structure
- Conduct Needs and Resource Assessments
- Embed Partnerships in School Environment
- ➤ Hire additional Key Personnel After School Coordinator, Parent/Community Outreach Coordinator
- Market and Begin Implementation of Programs



Timeline: Year 3 - 5

Integrated Programs Fully Operational

- Advisory Board Members meet regularly to provide support, feedback and problem solving work around key areas of community school development and sustainability.
