SUBJECT: Request Approval of a Five-Year Charter Renewal for Discovery Academy of

Science Charter School and Add Second Location

BACKGROUND:

The School Board approved Discovery Academy of Science Charter School's application in November 2011. The original K-12 charter was approved for 900 students. Currently, there are 156 students enrolled in grades K-5. The school requests the approval of their charter renewal for a five-year term. In addition, the school plans to move their upper grades to a new location at St. Mark's Church in Dunedin while maintaining their lower grades at their current location. According to the school's charter, a move beyond two miles requires School Board approval.

STRATEGIC DIRECTION: Student Achievement

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. Approve the five-year charter renewal and second location.
- 2. Do not approve the five-year charter renewal and second location.

RECOMMENDATION:

Alternative No. 1 is recommended.

RATIONALE:

The school received a state grade of A for the 2014-2015 school year. The current facility will not accommodate the projected growth of the school.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

If approved, the impact to the district will result in a loss of FTE dollars for each additional Pinellas County School student who chooses to enroll in Discovery Academy of Science Charter School.
