Summer will soon be here, and Pinellas County Schools is thrilled to share information about our **Summer Bridge** program. Summer Bridge is an extended learning opportunity designed for all students. The purpose of this exciting program is to provide students with continuous learning throughout the summer to ensure they will be ready to begin the next school year with confidence and success.

Summer Bridge will provide learning opportunities for six weeks during the summer, so students will be more prepared for success when the 2019-2020 school year begins. The 22-day program will include acceleration and enhancement of skills in reading, mathematics and science and individualized instruction in the three core subjects using a blended model of the arts, technology, small group instruction, hands-on labs and project-based learning.

Parents may choose to register their student(s) at any one of the 40 elementary sites, however please be advised that parents will be responsible for providing transportation for their child to and from the Summer Bridge Elementary School program. The program hours will be from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Mondays-Thursdays from June 11 to July 18, 2019. Please note: there will be no classes on July 4, 2019.

BEFORE AND AFTER CHILDCARE: Pinellas County Schools is partnering with the Juvenile Welfare Board (JWB), which will fund before and aftercare for a limited number of students who participate in the Elementary Summer Bridge program and are eligible for **free or reduced lunch**. You are strongly encouraged to register immediately to take advantage of this valuable summer learning opportunity. Families interested in this service who are not eligible for free or reduced lunch may participate in before and aftercare for a weekly fee. This will give your child access to before and after childcare at the school site. Childcare is available from 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and all day on Friday. Parents wishing to take advantage of this service through the YMCA or R'Club programs must complete the registration packet for this service. Packets can be requested from the YMCA or R'Club.
