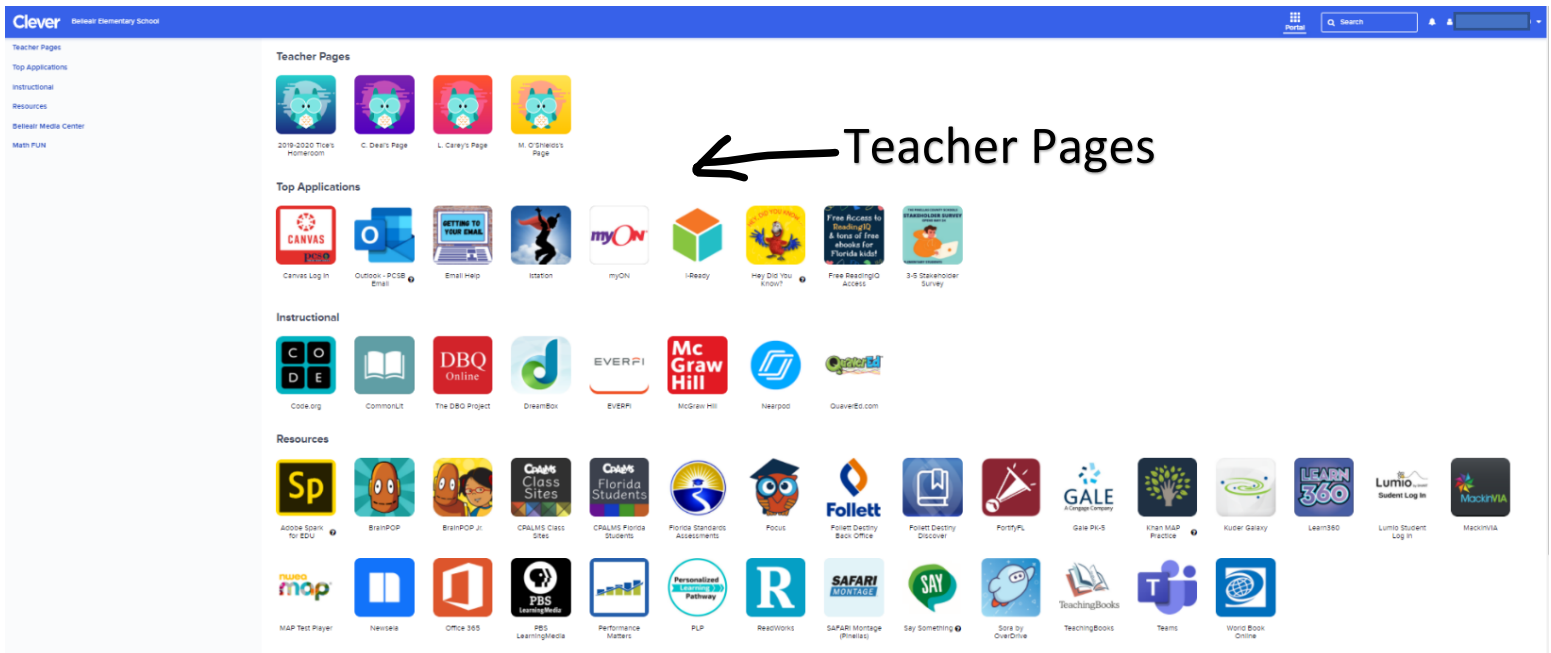


An Introduction to the Clever Dashboard for Elementary (Parent Directions)



Teacher Pages

The first pages you will see are the Teacher Pages. Your student's teacher may have a page where they share applications they use in class or feel will be helpful for your child to use.

A Few Applications Elementary Students Have



Canvas – Teachers use Canvas courses to place work and information for students about their classes.



Outlook – PK-12 students have access to their district email using this application. Only district staff can email students, they are not able to email each other, and people outside of our organization are not able to email them. Student emails are their username plus @pcsb.org (Ex. R2.D2@pcsb.org)



Istation – This is a reading application used in our elementary schools. Your child's teacher will share the weekly usage expectations for this app.



myON – This application provides all PK-5 students access to eBooks they can read online.



i-Ready – All K-5 students access their math textbook and other materials in this app.



Dreambox – This application provides practice and enrichment in math for students in grades K-5. Your child's teacher will share the weekly usage expectations for this app.



BrainPOP – This application provides videos and other resources to reinforce the concepts students are learning.



BrainPOP Jr. – This application provides videos and other resources to reinforce the concepts students are learning.



Newsela – This application is available to students and provides non-fiction news articles for them to read. The reading level can be adjusted on each article to match the reading level of your child.

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Office 365 – Students have access to tools like Word, PowerPoint, Excel and SWAY through this app. Students might be prompted to log in with their district email: username@pcsb.org (e.g., R2.D2@pcsb.org).



Code.org – All students have access to this app. Students can log in and learn how computer coding works through interactive lessons and challenges.



CommonLit – Students in grades 3-12 have access to this app. It provides articles students can read to strengthen their reading skills. Teachers often assign items for students to complete in this app.



Adobe Spark – Students can use this app to create videos and presentations to share in class.



Personalized Learning Pathway (PLP) – Provides all students with practice activities tailored to their needs along with a dashboard to help them track their journey through Pinellas County Schools.

These applications provide students access to eBooks they can checkout and read for free online.

Follett Destiny Back Office – Students can check out physical books using the catalog in this app as well and pick them up at their school's media center.
