**State of the School Address** by Audrey

- Bridging the Gap: 6 goals from the district (grad rate, student achievement, advanced coursework, student discipline, ESE identification, minority hiring). Strategies include equity champions, PBIS/restorative practices/SEL, culturally relevant teaching.
- Focus on subgroups shows our ESE proficiency scores are very strong and our L25 gains need improvement in ELA. Science up 5 points from year before. Math proficiency is strong and showing strong correlation with ST Math completion.

**SIP Review for Approval** by Audrey and Tameka

- School mission: We will partner with families to inspire a love for learning as students achieve personal goals.
- Three priorities to move our school forward: Culturally Relevant Teaching, Student-Centered with Rigor, Formative Assessment.
- Academic Goals: ELA increase from 57% to 63%, Math increase from 72% to 77%, Science from 68% to 73%.
- Healthy Schools goal is to maintain a silver status. The only thing holding back from moving to gold is staff vending machines. Loubet will talk to SBLT to send out a survey.
