*Please make certain to have your student well rested and on time to school. It is time for our students to shine!*

### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Parent awareness and support is a crucial part of the assessment process, and we would like to inform you of an important rule that will be in effect during FSA Testing.

Students have not historically been permitted to have electronic devices in their possession during testing. This year, if your child is found with an electronic device that reproduces, transmits, calculates, or records (e.g., a cell phone, camera, or pager) in his or her pocket, at his or her desk, or within his or her reach during testing, the test will be invalidated.

Please make sure your child is on time and well rested.

Results will reflect all of their hard work during the school year. Please plan in advance to have them at school by avoiding travel and doctor visits. Children test better with their peers in familiar surroundings.

- Students should bring a water bottle to school with them; pencils will be provided
- Be prepared for students to leave at the end of the test sessions. Approximately 2 ½ hours for writing and 2 hours for Reading, Math & Science test sessions
