Your Voice Matters: Federal education grants — totaling \$9 million for Pinellas County Schools (PCS), \$400 million for the state of Florida — were unexpectedly frozen on June 30, just before the fiscal year started.

That leaves our district unable to plan or execute key programs, including an **enhanced middle school experience, professional learning to support teacher growth and retention, and more.** These initiatives are now at risk.
