

#### Parents,

The 6o Science Power Words support vocabulary within the elementary Florida Science Standards. The purpose of sharing these words is to provide you with a resource for reinforcing the connections between focused vocabulary in the elementary science standards to real world learning experiences.

## Please see the examples below:

If you see a bee flying from flower to flower, the word *pollination* can be connected to the experience. If it is raining outside, the word *precipitation* can be connected to the experience. If you add sugar to ice tea, the word *dissolve* can be added to the shared experience.
