



Attention K-5 Educators! A new book delivery program is now available to all public and district-sponsored charter schools to help students who are not yet reading on grade level. The New Worlds Reading Initiative (NWRI) has officially launched and is delivering books to the homes of enrolled **eligible** students each month through June, completely **free** of charge.

The program is designed to create at-home libraries for K-5 students identified as not yet reading on grade level and foster a love for reading among students and their families. Book delivery began December 2021 and will continue this year through June 2022. Beginning fall 2022, books will be delivered from October through June each year.

Enrollment for NWRI is still open to eligible families. Messaging and flyers have been provided to schools to build excitement for the program and create a smooth enrollment process among eligible families. If you have not yet received flyers and resources for NWRI, please ask your school administrators for these items to share with **eligible** students and families. Teachers play an invaluable role in helping children enroll in the program.
