

Principal's Message – August 5, 2021

Hello and welcome to our new families and to a brand-new school year. I am extremely proud to report our district calculations have us on track to receive an A grade from the state based on the Spring FSA assessments. Our students and staff worked very hard for this achievement and it shows!

PreK through fifth grade's Meet the Teacher is on Tuesday, August 10th, from 1:00-2:30 pm. We hope you can stop by for a brief 5-10 minute "meet and greet" that day. The class lists are posted on the office doors and staff will be in the halls assisting as needed. As a reminder, class lists are subject to change due to changes with enrollment numbers.

Parents of Kindergarten through fifth grade can walk their child to class the first day of school, August 11. Since PreK students will always have a teacher escorting them to class, Pre-K parents will drop their students off in the car circle in front of the office starting at 8:15 am.

For now, masks are optional. We will continue to sanitize and limit activities around campus. Water fountains will still be closed so please have your student bring a water bottle labeled with their name on it. Water bottle should only have water. Please visit the district website for the most current information regarding COVID-19.

Our dismissal will be staggered again this year with Pre-K starting at 2:40 pm, Kindergarten at 2:45 pm, and all others at 2:55 pm. Please do not enter the car circle until your child's designated dismissal time so we can safely and efficiently dismiss kindergarten and PreK students first. Otherwise, you will be asked to exit and return later.
