- 5. Fully complete the application and submit letters of recommendation, an essay, and copies of their official sealed high school transcript, ACT and/or SAT scores.

PTA PROUD – Four of your LHS PTSA board members (including one student) received a grant from the Florida PTA to attend the *All Children Are Our Children State Summit* on Saturday, December 3rd. The summit took place at Middleton High School in Tampa. Other PTAs/PTSAs from around the state were present. We heard from representatives of the Pinellas County Schools HEAT group (Homeless Education and Assistance Team); a panel of speakers discussing the Juvenile Justice system; Zackary Gibson (Chief Child Advocate and Director of the Office of Adoption and Child Protection for the State of Florida); a representative from

the Guardian Ad Litem program; and we ran into some friends – BACA (Bikers Against Child Abuse). The summit included information from National PTA on ESSA and some hands-on projects involving Direct File and Civil Citations. 
