Parents, students, educators, and the community are invited to attend and learn more about this widespread issue. Learn why dating violence is a public health problem; how it affects the health and well-being of our youth; who is at risk; and what we can do to prevent dating violence.

A 2013 survey by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) found approximately 10% of high school students reported physical victimization and 10% reported sexual victimization from a dating partner in the 12 months before they were surveyed.
