Introduction & Welcome: MP

Adoption of Minutes: Motion-JS. Second-MP. Unanimously passed.

Old Business:

- MP would like to set up a meeting with other districts at FLVDVIPN to share work the on 5-hour mental health course. EFJ will join this meeting. MS will place our PCSB Mental Health course in Canvas Commons.
- JS shared an update on Chick-fil-A spirit night. It will need to be a week night 5-7 pm. Guests will mention PVS, and 20% will be donated to our school. We also have the option to add a spinning wheel game (charge \$1 per spin) where guests can try to earn free menu items. PVS is responsible for promoting this event. MH suggested also promoting which teachers will attend. JS will try to secure the Countryside and Clearwater locations for 3/26/20. If the event proves to be successful, other spirit nights further south and further north can be set-up, but each restaurant has different operators, so it will need to be a case-by-case request.
- JS shared mascot ideas: wildfire (wifi), night owls, lightning and slogan ideas: "virtual anything" (column of words to express convenience and possibilities) and "literally virtual". JS would also like to develop something with Baby Yoda since that's big in pop culture. JS will see if he can get some shirt prototypes done before FLDVIPN so that we can field test them (navy blue was suggested). MP would like JS to present the top

two mascot and slogan ideas at the 2/7 faculty meeting so that we can receive feedback and possibly generate other options.

New Business:

- MP shared that 5 seniors graduated in December, and there are 8 seniors slated for spring graduation; however, it's likely that only 4-5 of them will walk in the ceremony. Only the PVS leadership team will be required to attend. Remote employees will have the option to attend. MP has a poem in the program for the senior who passed way. MH will investigate some other appropriate ways for honoring this student.
- MP explained that Dr. Thomas would like to use SIP funds for a camera that would assist with science experiments. \$129.99 Logitech webcam + \$9 freight. This aligns with the SIP goal of improving middle school science scores. Motion-JS. Second-MH. Unanimously passed.
- MH will investigate any additional needs Dr. Thomas may have and then remind staff (on behalf of the SAC) that funds are available to improve reading, math, and science scores. Those funds should be spent by end of May.
