SAC Meeting Minutes
February 17, 2021

Introduction & Welcome: MP

Adoption of Minutes: Motion-JS. Second-MP. Unanimously passed.

Old Business: None

New Business:

- MP shared that 31 seniors indicated they will walk in the graduation ceremony. An additional 4 seniors indicated they will not walk but would like to receive covered diplomas, and that number is expected to increase.
- MP explained that it would be helpful to use SIP funds for diploma covers this year since we have a significantly higher number of seniors. The plan would be to order 50 covers at a cost of \$7 each for a total of \$350. MP will investigate and ensure that this is an appropriate use of the funding, but to keep things moving, she requested pre-approval from SAC. Motion-JS. Second-MH. Unanimously passed.
- Graduation is scheduled for 6/9 (9:30 am) at Bayside High School. The district is exploring the idea of overflow seating outside the gym in order to comply with CDC social distancing guidelines. An alternative has been presented as 6/10 (9:30 am) at Largo High School if the district determines that COVID-19 cases warrant further restrictions.
- JS will address students during the ceremony in his capacity as SAC chairperson. He offered to yield this task to the parent council member, but CP declined.
- JS suggested a full run-through of the ceremony be conducted--even virtually if necessary. MP agreed this would be a good idea.
- MP asked that SAC reconvenes closer to graduation when the district has made final decisions about locations and processes.

Report(s):

- Principal: Looking ahead to next year, full-time enrollments are expected to remain higher than they were pre-COVID-19. Students will go through the normal district application process.

Open Agenda:

- CP shared that he would like to see us move forward with the school branding/mascot initiative that we began prior to COVID-19. MP suggested a SAC meeting over summer in hopes of having school merchandise available for students and staff at the beginning of the 2021/2022 school year.
