- All 6th grade testing and 8th grade science is paper based. All other testing is computer based.
- Students will be using school- based computers in our computer labs. Students will not use their 1:1 device for testing. Students are **strongly encouraged** to leave devices and electronics at home each day of testing.
- **Students are discouraged from bringing book bags on the day of testing.** Student cell phones will be collected by the proctor and returned at the end of the testing each testing session.
- Students **will not** be allowed water bottles or snacks “during testing times”. During breaks, students may use the restroom or get a drink of water. Students will be encouraged to use the restroom prior to the start of testing.
- 7th and 8th grade students will use headphones on the Reading testing days. Students may bring their own headphones or utilize school headphones.
- Student calculators are used on 7th and 8th grade math and science testing. Students will use school testing approved calculators.
- Headphones and calculators will be cleaned between usage.
- MyPCS online students will check in at the table by the front office to receive their testing ticket (room number, seat number, test password).
- In person students will receive their testing ticket with their first period teacher. Students must hold onto their testing ticket each day of testing.
- MyPCS online students may be picked up from school at the end of their testing session (total minutes). Students may also be picked up at the end of the school day. Supervision will be provided after the testing session.
- MYPCS online students, when on campus, will be in uniform dress code and wear a mask.
