#### ESOL (English to Speakers of Other Languages)

The ESOL Program at Northwest is currently in the ACCESS 2.0 testing cycle. ACCESS 2.0 is a secure largescale English language proficiency assessment administered to Kindergarten through 12th grade students who have been identified as English language learners (ELLs). The testing window opens Monday, Jan. 29 and closes March 23. All ESOL students in K-5 need to be tested in order to be in compliance with State regulations.
