

Happy New Year!

We hope you all had a restful, fun and WARM winter break! We have quite a bit happening this month. Report cards go home Jan, 19^{th} . On January 19^{th} we will be having an awards ceremony for grades 3-5. We want to recognize those students making Principal's list, Honor Roll, and great improvements (4^{th} -8:50-9:20, 5^{th} 9:25-9:55, 3^{rd} 10:00-10:30 in the cafeteria).

Students in grades 3-5 will be preparing for FSA. The Writing portion will be assessed the week of March 5th for grades four and five. This writing assessment is part 1 of the ELA assessment. Part 2 will be the reading portion given in April/May. In order for your child to have an ELA score they need to take both parts. Consider accessing the following link to take practice tests (ELA/Math): http://www.fsassessments.org. Go to students and families and then practice tests. This will help students prepare for the stamina required and lessen their anxiety. This will also help parents see what is being assessed and the rigor of the questions.
