

Laptops will be distributed this week, starting Thursday, May 4^{th} . Students will need to log in on campus prior to taking the computer home.

Each winter a Title I Parent Survey is conducted. Below were the Opportunities for Growth for Northwest:

- Establish or improve parent communication process. Only 67% indicated they were aware they had the opportunity to provide input into how Title I funds are spent at their school. In addition, 63% of the parents indicated awareness of the programs and resources provided by Title I funds, 69% reported knowing about Title I events at the school
- Include volunteer opportunities in school communication plans and process. Approximately 21% of the parents reported volunteering at the school, and 35% reported attending the Title I Annual Meeting.
- Consider child care needs when scheduling parent meetings and events. Approximately 20% of the parents indicated that child care needs prevented them from being more involved at their child's school.

Each Newsletter has a Title I Tid Bits section. We have promoted our SAC meetings for Title I input sessions.

Title I Annual Meeting information: Every year we hold our Title I Annual meeting on our Open House Night. We have a power point presentation broadcasted via televisions in the classroom prior to Open House activities. The power point communicates what Title I is, the funding allocated to Northwest, standards based curriculum, school based resources and Title I resources. We also promote Title I family events each month: Literacy Festival, Math Game Night, Safety Night and Science Night. Our Kindergarten Orientations are Title I funded as well.

Our Annual Meeting is held in conjunction with our Open House, the night before the First Day of School. We had app. 80% of parents/families in attendance.

Each spring we ask for parent input into the Title I Compact and Parent Involvement Plan, requirements of the Title I Program.

All family events include students. All Parent Focus Night meetings provided child care this year. SAC/PTA meetings allow for children to be present.
