What is SAC? The SAC assists in the preparation, implementation, and evaluation of the school improvement plan; promotes communication among students, staff, parents, administration, and the community; assist in the preparation of the school's annual budget; serve as a resource for the principal and perform such other functions as are requested by the principal.

School Operations (Dr. Gordon, Assistant Principal of Operations)

Our school safety and sanitizing procedures are in full swing. We are practicing **social distancing** in all areas of the school this includes **one directional hallways and stairways**. Each hall has hand sanitizer, and all classrooms are equipped with a **sanitizing station**. We have also implemented **staggered class transitions and dismissal** to minimize the number of students moving at one time. At the end of each school day, all classrooms are disinfected and sanitized. **Please remind your scholar to wear their mask so that it covers their mouth and nose. Also remind them to stay six feet apart from their classmates as they move through the hallways**. We will be conducting a safety drill this week. These drills prepare our students in case there is an emergency situation that arises.

Please remind all scholars that have been issued a laptop to store it in their book bag when not in use. This will reduce the chance of damage and costly repairs that take time and leave the scholar without a device.

School Expectations (Mr. Wicks, Assistant Principal of Athletics, Activities and Behavior Management)

For everyone's health, it is vital for our scholars to wear masks at all times while on campus (inside or outside), refrain from both physical contact whether we are talking about hugs, high fives, and handshakes or physical horseplay. Please discuss the importance of this during COVID -19 times with your scholar. Our goal is to have healthy students in class and online every day and every class. Please ensure that your scholar not only has a mask to wear at school; but also has extras in his/her bookbag. Numerous scholars are showing up to school daily without masks as well as masks can break during the day.

The best keys to great behavior are going to class right away and being highly involved and interactive during class. As a parent or guardian, please check Focus for your scholar's grades and discuss with them. **Great Behavior + Great Student Interaction = Great Grades**

A district decision was made last week to not have middle school athletics until 2nd semester. At that time, we will have three truncated seasons: volleyball, basketball, track. More information about tryouts for those seasons will come later as we approach the seasons.
