## To: Parents or Guardians of all 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

Your child **will not be permitted** to enter or attend the 7<sup>th</sup> grade in August 2021 without proof of the following immunizations:

- **One Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) booster**

For the school year **2021-2022**, students entering or attending **7<sup>th</sup> grade** are **REQUIRED** to have a **Tdap** (tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis) prior to attending class on the first day of school or valid documented exemption. This grade level is also required to have two **varicella** vaccines.

All schools in the county are required by Chapter 64D-3.046, Florida Administrative Code, to enforce these immunization requirements.

A completed Certificate of Immunization form (DH 680) is issued when the student has received all required immunizations. After your child has received these vaccines, please turn in this completed form to your child's school.

**Be sure to get started now, so your child is ready for the first day in August 2021!**
