- 1. In your sketchbook, view & critique modern and contemporary artists that inspire your work from both museum visits (virtually is acceptable) and your art research about 3 artists. Use at least 2 pages (or 1 page front and back) using writing and illustration to investigate the artist and their work. More details below.
- 2. Decide on 3 concentration topics that could potentially become your focus (Sustained Investigation) for the school year. Use at least 2 pages (or 1 page front and back) using brainstorming, journaling, or personal investigation to consider these themes.
- 3. <u>Fill the rest of the sketchbook</u> until the end with drawings, collage, photos, artists, or anything that inspires you. No judgement here- have fun with it! **Photographers**-instead of a sketchbook, you will take 10-20 photos per week, for a total of 100 photos. They can be saved on a flash drive to submit.
- 4. Complete 2 finished pieces as quality projects:
 - a. A Word and Image piece (images/art that connect to written text, lyrics, stories or poems) No larger than 16" x 20"
 - b. A Surreal 8" x 10" image. Your artwork must explore surreal concepts such as: transformation, displacement, juxtaposition, and/or image duality.
 - c. **DO NOT** complete these in your sketchbook. Any 2D media is acceptable, as long as it makes sense with your concentration. <u>Our first critique will be to share</u> these works.

Exploring Art & Resources

In order to understand visual art and what artists are doing, the best way is to experience it! You will need to visit **at least one** local art venue. If we are in quarantine at that time, virtual visits are also acceptable. Write about the exhibits and describe them in detail. Make a quick sketch of at least 3 of your favorite pieces (Photographers: you have to do this too).
