<u>Practice</u>: The first day of practice will be **Thursday**, **November 8th**, **4:10p-6p**. **There will be a parent meeting from 6-6:15pm**. Please come into the gym. A full practice and game schedule will be forthcoming.

You must be appropriately dressed out to participate in tryouts. All students trying out will be required to run a timed 1.5 miles.

In order to tryout:

- A. Must have a current GPA of 2.0 and have passed five subjects in the preceding grading period.
- B. **Must** have a current physical. Physicals are good for one year from the exam date. Your physical must not expire during the Basketball season. (YOUR DOCTOR HAS THIS FORM).
- C. Must have Pinellas County School Insurance for the 2017-18 school year. (GO ONLINE AND PRINT CONFIRMATION PAGE). <u>https://www.hsri.com/K12_Enrollment/Main/default.asp</u>
- D. **Must** have a current Pinellas County Schools Participation form. https://www.pcsb.org/cms/lib/FL01903687/Centricity/Domain/166/4-1891-B.pdf
- E. Must have a Basketball Agreement form signed by parent and student (BOTTOM OF THIS PAPER).
- F. Must turn paperwork in to the school bookkeeper by November 1st. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Students who make the team MUST:

- 1. Attend all practices and remain the full length required. Missing practices could result in dismissal from the team. Must have a ride to games and practices. To be excused from practices or games, <u>your coach must receive a parent</u> <u>email, letter, phone call, text or a doctor's note</u>.
- 2. Wear appropriate attire to practices athletic shorts, t-shirt, practice jersey, basketball shoes, and hair pulled off face.
- 3. Wear appropriate attire to all Games: uniform jersey and hair pulled off face. NO JEWELRY.
- 4. Adhere to Student Code of Conduct. Violation may result in suspension or dismissal from the team.
- 5. Maintain a 2.0 GPA throughout the entire season.
- 6. Bring fluids (water, Gatorade) to all practices and games to stay hydrated.
- 7. <u>Be POSITIVE! No negative attitudes will be tolerated. If you do not agree with a coach's decision, please communicate your concerns in a respectful manner.</u>
