What is Title I?

- Title I is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- The goal of Title I is a higher quality of education for every child.
- The program serves millions of children in public elementary and secondary schools each year.

How Title I Work?

- The federal government provides funding to states each year for the Title I program.
- The school district identifies eligible schools and distributes the Title I funds to the school.
- Oak Grove Middles School implements a school-wide program, all students benefit from the supplemental services provided by Title I. Every parent is a Title I parent.

This is how Title I Programs Provide Supplemental Support

- Smaller classes;
- Additional teachers and paraprofessionals
- Additional training for school staff
- Extra time for instruction (Before and/or after school programs)
- Parental Involvement Activities
- A variety of supplemental teaching methods and materials.

Who decides how funds are used?

- Every school has a School Advisory Council (SAC) composed of:
 - Parents, Teachers, Other staff that works at the school, Principal and Students (at Middle and High School) The School Advisory Council determines how to use Title I funds.
 - Oak Grove Middle School SAC Meeting, October 5th at 6pm in the OGMS Media Center.

JHMS Title 1 Allocation

- Title 1 allocation for OGMS is based on the number of students on free/reduced lunch
- 91% of OGMS Students are on free/reduce lunch
- Total Title I Budget is \$379,150.00
- Parent Involvement Budget is \$3,750.00

Utilization of Title 1 Funds

- Professional Development Stipends
- Extended Learning Program Salaries (tutorials, evening learning day and extended learning summer)
- Classroom instructional materials
- Technology to support instruction and student achievement.
