Welcome Back Thunderbird Parents:

We will be doing our registrations by appointment only this year. You can sign up for an appointment through our Front Desk Clerk or you contact Ms. Francois at francoisg@pcsb.org. Please note that not all times will be available, as they go fast, but we will continue to work with our parents to make the registration process a smooth transition for all families.

Required Documents

Birth certificate or other proof of identity/age:

Students must be 5 years old on or before Sept. 1 to attend kindergarten. Students must be 6 years old on or before Sept. 1 and have completed kindergarten to attend grade 1. All students new to Pinellas County Schools must present proof of identity/age. For other items that may be accepted as legal evidence of birth, call your child's assigned school.

Proof of residency:

Present one of each of the following items: utility bill for power or water and your rental agreement or lease/closing document (full documents, **WE** will make copies); Pinellas County tax statement with homestead exemption. The items must be recent and contain the name of the parent/guardian and service address on them. If any of these documents are not in the name of the parent or guardian, you must complete an Affidavit of Residency. The Affidavit of Residency document is available at schools and by visiting the district website at www.pcsb.org. It must be completed, notarized on both sides and submitted with one of the items listed in the name of the parent of the parent of the parent of the parent of the parent.

Child's Social Security number:

School system personnel are required to ask for this, but students are not required to have them.

Child's most recent report card:

This is required for students entering grades 1-12. All Report Card should include the school's address and phone number, especially if they are coming from out of state, country or district. This is a must to complete the registration process.

Florida Certificate of Immunization:

All students must have a completed Florida Certificate of Immunization (DOH 680) appropriate for their grade level. <mark>You must go to the Health Department and have your</mark> document transferred to the Florida DOH 680 form, before registration.

Physical examination certificate:

All students entering a Pinellas County School must have a school health examination certificate signed by a licensed examiner (certificate must have been issued within 12 months prior to enrollment/registration).

A recent Individual Education Plan (IEP):

If the student participates in exceptional student education, he or she must have an IEP.
