### SHMS MyPCS Online Learning

On the first day of school...

Open the laptop

Login to Clever

Click on Canvas

From the dashboard view "Upcoming Events" on right side of screen

Click on your task or assignment or first meeting ex: "First Period Live Lesson" to join the class.

The same will repeat for each class.

### SHMS Traditional Learning

Have your child login to portal and see their schedule.

Identify their first period teacher.

When looking at the room number, the 1st number (before the dash) is the building number. The number after the dash will tell you which floor (1 is downstairs and 2 is upstairs). The 3-digits after number after the dash is the room number.

If your student is not able to login to Portal, please contact your child's grade level office.

Please review our School Entrance & Exit Map with your child so they know how to get from their drop off area onto campus.

On the first day of school...

All students will receive a paper copy of their schedule during first period.

Throughout the day our staff will be there to assist students from class to class!

## Organizational Tools

Binder/Divider/Pouch and Safety Harbor MS Planner will be sold in first period for 5 dollars. Families may certainly purchase their own supplies, however we wanted to offer you this opportunity at below cost. We are asking for 5 dollars, but if you family can support another child please send an additional 5 dollars with your child. Your consideration is appreciated.



## Face Masks

- Students will always wear masks while at school, even during arrival and dismissal, unless they are eating or during a time set aside for a mask break. Approved masks must completely cover the student's nose and mouth. We recommend writing your child's name on the inside of the mask if possible.
- All students will receive five washable masks at the beginning of the school year, students may wear their own mask if it completely covers their nose and mouth.

## Sanitation

- Our plant operators will be cleaning high touch surfaces throughout the day.
- Teachers are supplied with cleaning kits and there will be a thorough sanitation at the end of each day by the plant operation staff.
- After each classroom is cleaned there will be a sign hanging from the door to indicate the classroom is ready for occupancy.



## Classroom Environments

- Student seating has been revised to allow for the largest space possible between student desks.
- Hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the campus to ensure that students clean their hands throughout the day. All teachers have hand sanitizer in their classroom.
- Students may bring their own sanitizer to school and will have access to it throughout the day.



## Student Wellness Expectations

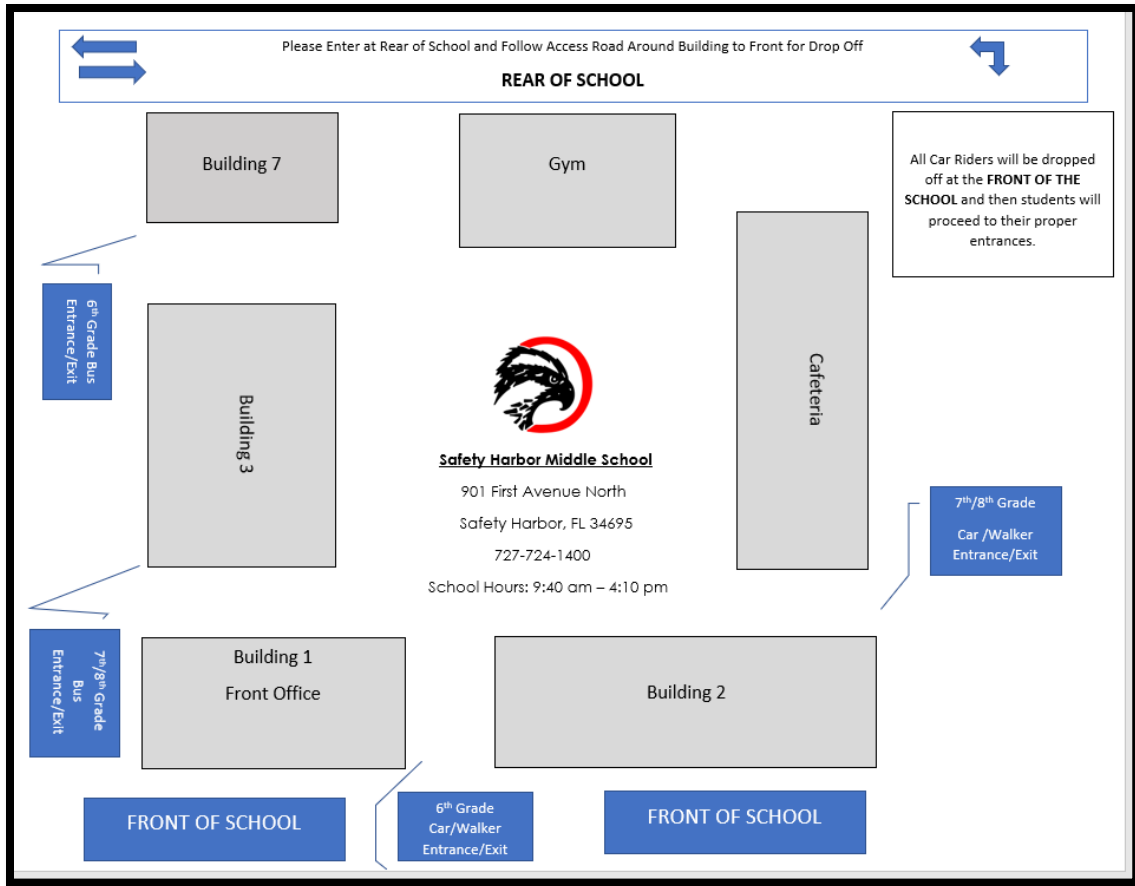
Each day parents will be asked to assess their child's health before bringing them to school. Students with any of the following symptoms should not come to school:

- Temperature above 100.4/chills
- Vomiting or gastrointestinal issues
- Chronic cough/shortness of breath
- Loss of taste or smell
- In general, if your child is not well, they should stay home
- Been in close contact (15 minutes or more at less than 6 ft) with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 in the past 14 days

Students who exhibit any of these symptoms while at school will receive care in a space away from other students and staff. Parents will be called to pick up their child immediately. ## Morning Arrival

- All students will receive their paper schedule in first period on Monday, August 24<sup>th</sup>. Your first period room location can be found in FOCUS, and will be posted on the building 1 windows and in each grade level house. There will be many adults to help with this process.
- Students will enter areas of the school building based on their grade level. (see map below) A staggered opening of doors will begin at 9:15 am. Students are welcome to eat breakfast and then proceed to their first period class.



- Students should stand on the X's as their wait for their entrance to open.



- Bike riders may lock your bike in the north or south bike rack and proceed to your entrance according to your grade level.
- Once car riders leave the vehicle they are to move to their designated entrance.
- School buses will be unloaded one at a time to allow for a socially distanced staggered entrance.



## Lunch

- We will have 4 lunches this year. A process for determining lunch will be reviewed in second period. Students will sit two at a table in assigned seats.




- Students will be reminded to wash their hands and use hand sanitizer during lunch. Hand sanitizer and a hand washing station is available in the cafeteria.
- Dismissal to lunch will be staggered. Teachers will be informed of when they will be released for lunch. All teachers will walk their students to the café. Expectation is that ALL students will walk directly to the café and not wait for friends.



- Once in the café the students will sit at the table in designated seats as directed.
- All students should keep their masks on until they are eating their food. Students should replace the mask when done.
- Students will sit at their table and wait to be called by the administrator.
- All students will follow directions and maintain social distancing while in line. Masks MUST be worn while in line. Students should immediately get their food and return to their table.
- The administrator will dismiss from lunch, not the bell. Upon dismissal, students should immediately report to their next class.
- Until a routine is established a small number of students may be late for the period following lunch. These instances will be excused. It is vital your child has enough time to eat lunch. As processes become refined so will the timing.

### Dismissal

- We will conduct a staggered dismissal every day. Students should exit through the same doors as they entered in the morning according to the map.
- Bus riders will be provided a bus card which will dismiss them from their 7<sup>th</sup> period class when their bus arrives.
- Above all please be patient as we work together to get all families, staff members and students acclimated to this new procedure. The car line is especially heavy during the first several weeks of school. Thank you for your patience.
