If this signed contract is not returned in person to Ms. Dupee, the student may NOT participate in the event.

_____ I understand that Halloween Dance tickets must be purchased in advance, and this signed contract must be submitted in person to Ms. Dupee during lunch October 24–28.

_____ I understand that the ticket cost is \$10.00 / \$15.00 / \$20.00 and payment must be made in advance.

_____ I understand that tickets are **non-refundable for any reason**, including disciplinary ineligibility, incomplete paperwork, or failure to attend. Tickets may not be exchanged or resold.

_____ I understand that a valid ticket is required for entry to the dance.

_____ I understand and agree that my student will follow the Pinellas County Schools Code of Student Conduct and all event rules and regulations.

Expectations for Behavior

Students will be supervised by faculty and adult chaperones. All school rules, including the Pinellas County Schools Code of Student Conduct, apply during the event. Violations may result in disciplinary action, including restrictions on participation in future events.

The following guidelines will be strictly enforced:

1. Students must arrive on time. **No entry after 7:00 PM.** Late arrivals will not be admitted, and no refunds will be issued.
2. Once admitted, students may not leave and re-enter the event.
3. Possession, use, or influence of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, Juuls, or vaping products is strictly prohibited and will result in serious disciplinary consequences.
4. Students may not enter restricted or unauthorized areas at any time.
5. No refunds will be issued if a student is denied entry or removed for violation of any rule or for any reason deemed appropriate by PHMS staff.

6. Students must be picked up **no later than 8:15 PM** (15 minutes after the event ends). Consequences may be assigned for students remaining after the pick-up deadline.
