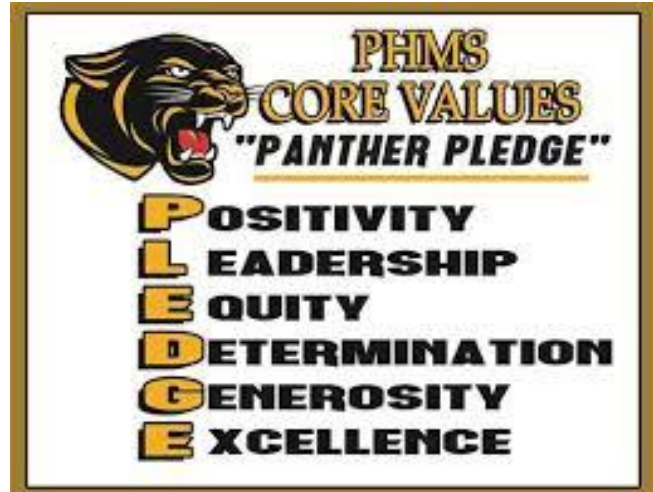
SAC Committee brings on a NEW Beautification Outreach program and we need YOUR HELP!
