Scholars should be using programs found in Clever or on their teacher's Clever page. This keeps the device free from malware, viruses, and other problems. Also, please be mindful of using programs like Netflix or YouTube to watch videos that are not educationally based. The contract signed by all parents upon computer checkout says that the computer will be used for educational purposes only.







