- have the approval signature of an Assistant Principal
- have the approval signature of a parent/guardian
- attend the Prom on 4/1.

With this application, Candidates must complete and turn in **ALL** the following to be eligible:

_____ All completed paperwork due no later than **Friday, March 10th, by 2:00 pm in room 220 in person. Do NOT place any applications in my mailbox and do NOT send by a friend.**

_____ I must have my attendance clerk sign off on my discipline record and progress report.

_____ Parent or guardian must sign and agree to the terms.

_____ I must have the approval signature from my administrator to become an applicant for the 2023 Prom court.

_____ I must include a picture no larger than 3"x3". I understand that the picture I submit will be on display for all students to see. **Pictures will not be returned.**

If I am selected as a 2023 Prom Court Applicant, I fully understand and agree to the terms listed above. I **will campaign only after I have received approval as a Prom Court Applicant**, and I will remove posted flyers after the election.
