A CAPE ACADEMY

THE PURPOSE OF THE ENGINEERING PROGRAM IS TO INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO THE FUNDAMENTALS OF MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL, AND INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING. STUDENTS WILL ALSO MAKE USE OF SEVERAL DESIGN PROGRAMS, INCLUDING SOLIDWORKS AND AUTOCAD.

THE ENGINEERING PROGRAM IS ALSO A HANDS-ON COURSE, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO DESIGN AND TEST PARTS, AS WELL AS WORK WITH 3-D MODELING (WHICH WILL HELP WITH FINDING JOBS IN THAT FIELD, AND A BUNCH OF MORE EQUIPMENT IN THE LAB


