Purchasing Tickets

Parent or Guardian's Initials _____

- To purchase tickets, you must be an 11th or 12th grade Countryside Student. You may only buy two tickets: one for you and one for your guest.
- All guests must meet the following criteria:
 - 2.0 unweighted GPA
 - No disciplinary issues (will be taken under consideration)
 - No attendance issues (will be reviewed)
 - Fulfill all financial obligations on campus
- Tickets will be purchased on REVTRAK. Once your ticket is purchased, you're consenting to following the guidelines listed on this expectation form. No refunds will be given.
- **Tickets will be sold on REVTRAK ONLY between the dates of February 13th –April 27th at the price of \$65 plus the cost of REVTRAK fees.**
- Students MUST turn in signed CHS Prom Expectations and Guidelines Forms and have all obligations fulfilled prior to the week of Prom.
- *Students will have the opportunity to turn in the applicable forms and proof of cleared financial obligations on the following dates Thursday, April 6, 2023, Thursday April 13, 2023, Thursday, April 19, and Thursday, April 27th after school at the table in front of the main office. After this time students will be leaving this in the prom guidelines basket in the main office or drop off this form with Mrs. Gray in room L8 or Mrs. DeRosa in room J1.*
- Printed tickets are just for a keepsake and the official list of purchased tickets is from Rev Track, students name must be on this list to be granted entry.
- *The first 200 students will be guaranteed to receive prom favors.*

Attire and Conduct Guidelines

- Students are expected to be in FORMAL ATTIRE (**Formal attire means "dressed up"**)
 - Dress pants and dress shirts, suits or a tuxedo. Pants securely worn at the waist and shoes are also a must.
 - Dresses, dress pants or dress skirts and dress shirt. All dresses should be of appropriate for a school event. Length-not above the thigh, nothing see through, no low plunging necklines.
 - No shorts. No jeans, pants should be formal, khakis are allowed. Dress shirts should have a collar.
 - **No eye masks allowed.**
- Dancing must remain appropriate to a school environment. Suggestive or dangerous dancing will be stopped and those participating may be removed from the premises.
- Students are responsible for the behavior of any invited guest; **both parties will be dismissed if anyone is not meeting expectations.**
- Once admitted to the prom, you will not be allowed to leave and re-enter. **THIS INCLUDES GOING TO YOUR CAR. No re-entry, no exceptions.**

- If your guest changes, you must change the guest's name with Mrs. Gray or Mrs. DeRosa by 2:25 p.m. on April 27, 2023 or email Mrs. Gray with your change at grayjenn@pcsb.org, as she will not be on campus on April 28, 2023. You must show your student I.D. and copy of new guest's I.D./license. (If you change your guest, you will not get another gift. It is your responsibility to personally exchange your gift with your new guest.)
