

What to look for in your scholar's agenda

The agenda will be a resource for you and your scholar's teacher to communicate daily so that you can see how their day was and keep up with their homework assignments.

- ✓ We are asking that an adult initial your scholar's agenda nightly to indicate the scholar's homework is up to date and their daily score was checked by their family:
- ✓ Homework will be assigned weekly, Mon-Thurs.
 - The intent of the assigned homework is for scholars to continue to practice what they are learning in class each day.
- ✓ Each day your scholar's teacher will record a score in the column for that day in the agenda. This score indicates how many points your scholar earned which gives their families an idea of how their day went.
- ✓ We encourage our families the agendas for quicker notes (change in dismissal plan, request for call or conference, words of encouragement for scholar, etc...) and to use the DOJO messaging for longer communications.
 - ANY important discussions will be taken care of over the phone to eliminate confusion and make all stakeholders are on the same page TOGETHER.
- ✓ We recommend parents check the Class Dojo App where you will be able to see more specifics as to where each of the scholars' points were earned or missed each day and have conversations about what you are noticing. We ALWAYS recommend celebrating as much as possible.
- ✓ As a bonus recognition, scholars can earn a High-Flying Hawk point for being a positive member of their classroom community.
