Pinellas County Schools families,

As you may know, Florida adopted new state education standards and changed the way testing is done in our schools. The new Florida Assessment of Student Thinking - or FAST - is a progress monitoring assessment for reading and math that will be administered, three times per year, to track your student's progress in learning the required materials within Florida's Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards.

The first progress monitoring assessment (PM1) will be administered September 1st (Reading), math will be administered September 7th

You can find out more information about the test and see sample questions at <u>flfast.org/families</u>. Once on the site, just select the grade band appropriate for your student(s).

Please note that these are **progress monitoring** assessments. It is important to know that although this test is taking place at the beginning of the year, students will be answering questions that cover the entire year's curriculum. We know and expect that there will be low scores to start, and those scores will rise and show their progress during the mid-year and end-of-year progress monitoring assessments.

The results of this first assessment will only be used to help teachers understand what areas to focus on with students. It is important that students take the assessment seriously, so teachers have accurate information to use for planning future lessons. The district will send communications to all families with how to access your student's results when they are available.
