Program	Description	Dates	How to enroll
Credit Recovery	For students who earned a "D" or "F" in a semester or full year of English, Math*, Science or Social Studies and needs to retake them for graduation required credits. *If Algebra 1-A or Algebra 1 needs to be recovered you will need to take that through Summer Bridge (see below).	June 2 - July 17	Counselors will provide a list of eligible students. Verify with your students' school counselor or have the student show up on June 2 nd to register.
Summer Bridge Algebra 1 or 1A Credit Recovery	For current 9th and 10th grade students who have failed one or both semesters of Algebra 1 or 1A.	June 16 – June 26	Log into your Parent Focus account and access the "Student Reservation System" link on the left navigation pane.
<mark>Summer Bridge</mark> Algebra 1 EOC Prep	For current 9th and 10th grade students who need to prepare for the state's Algebra 1 EOC test. No high school credits are earned during Algebra 1 EOC prep. This program is for test prep and the EOC retake.	June 30 - July 10 (students will take the Alg 1 EOC retake July 14 th)	Log into your Parent Focus account and access the "Student Reservation System" link on the left navigation pane.
Summer Bridge ACT Reading and/or Math Preparation	For current 10th and 11th grade students to prep for success on the ACT and potentially earn a concordant score for graduation. No high school credits are earned during ACT test prep. This course is for test prep and the ACT exam.	June 30 - July 10 (students will take the ACT on Saturday, July 12 th)	Log into your Parent Focus account and access the "Student Reservation System" link on the left navigation pane.
