Summer Bridge Week 1 – Week of June 2, 2025

Our first day of Summer Bridge is Monday, June 2^{nd} . Whether students are car riders, bus riders, walkers, or bike riders to school; please consider the following:

- o This summer we will serve students in grades Rising K-4
- Our student Summer Bridge student hours are 8:00am 12:00pm M-Thurs. We are closed on Fridays. The YMCA will relocate to Lynch Elementary on Fridays.
- o Our Summer Bridge staff hours are 7:30am-12:30pm

- o Our Summer Bridge front office summer hours are 7:30-am-12:30pm
- Students are not permitted on campus until 7:40am (unless enrolled in the YMCA).
- The latest time for YMCA morning drop-off in bus circle is at 7:40am. After 7:40am, parents must use the car circle.
- Our car circle gate for morning drop-off will open at 7:40am and close promptly at 8:00am.
- o Car riders must be dropped off in the designated area (car circle only)
- o ALL students must use the single point of entry (car circle) to gain access to our campus.
- O **Bus transportation** will be provided for students who received transportation during the school year. The summer bus routes are the same routes used during the school year. All bus routing information was shared and sent home with students prior to the last day of school upon request by the parent. As of today, we have a total of two students scheduled to ride the bus, meaning most of our students will be car riders, YMCA or walkers.
- o Afternoon dismissal for grades Rising-K- grade 4 students will begin at 12:00pm
- As during the regular school year, all students arriving before 8:00am must report directly to the cafeteria via the car line drop-off.
- Students arriving after 8:00am will be marked as tardy and must enter through our front office.
- o Breakfast and Lunch are free to all students and served daily. Students may bring their own lunch.
- o Uniforms are allowed, but not mandatory during Summer Bridge

Summer Bridge Communication

In an effort to reduce the use of paper, we will continue to communicate with our families in the following ways:

- o The Bear Creek website will be our primary source of Summer Bridge communication at https://www.pcsb.org/bearcreek-es.
- School Messenger will be used occasionally to remind families to visit our website for weekly updates and time-sensitive information.
- Teachers will communicate their preferred method of communication over the next four weeks in their first day Summer Bridge packets.

Summer Bridge Rising K (Pre-K going into K)

- Our Rising K staff are Mrs. Jessica Brown (Teacher)/Ms. Jeanette Lewis (Child Development Associate).
- o If attending the YMCA, Rising K students will be picked up and dropped off at the cafeteria.
- o Please send an extra set of clothing for all Rising K students should an accident occur.
- o Rising K students will have breakfast and lunch in the cafeteria.

 - Please return all completed forms the following day.
 - If your child is going to be absent, please contact the front office to let them know.
