Classroom Guidance has started in all the classrooms. At least once a month, I go into each classroom and teach important social emotional skills that support their growth and success both in and out of school.

Classroom Guidance Topics

August – Career Exploration

We use a program on Clever called XELLO. This program allows your child to explore their interests and skills to better understand themselves and learn about different careers for future success.

September – Feelings

Your child learned their THOUGHTS create FEELINGS which leads to an ACTION. Children who are able to identify their feelings are better able to communicate their needs and are more likely to understand the feelings of the people in their lives.

Things you are able to do at home to help your child understand emotions.

- Ask your child how they are feeling
- Share how you are feeling. Be specific
- Read stories with your child and talk about the feelings of the characters.

Character Trait of the Month

October – TOLERANCE

Respecting the individual differences, views, and beliefs of other people.

Each month one child from each class is chosen to represent the character trait.
