Collaborative Planning

- Prioritize weekly collaborative planning with all stakeholders (ESOL, ESE, ASD)
- Use an effective planning protocol to promote active participation within teams
- Use PLCs to analyze data from module assessments to best plan for reteach/enrichment opportunities based on data

Leadership & Ownership

- Data Team leaders to increase awareness of tools/strategies to improve data analysis for planning instruction
- Develop a team approach to planning for student's needs and delivering small group instruction for students not meeting benchmarks.
- Learning Walks to promote collaboration across campus

Instruction & Engagement

- Explicit planning for academic vocabulary and background knowledge across all content areas during collaborative planning
