## Start working in Study Island to earn great prizes!

## **How to WIN!**

- Make sure all your students have active Study Island accounts with content assigned to them. If they don't, be sure to distribute credentials to students and create a class in Study Island, as it makes pulling reports.
- **2.** Once the class is created you can assign lessons, flashcards, and practice topics.
- 3. Encourage students to work through their assigned content to [earn Blue Ribbons / correctly answer questions]. Students can also choose their own topics to practice within the program to earn Blue Ribbons. Blue Ribbons are earned when a student masters a topic, passing with a 70% mastery or higher.



**4.** Encourage students to **track their progress** by reviewing the Blue Ribbons area in their student homepage. As an educator, you can run several variations of reports for the duration of the contest to check in on individual progress. Depending on the parameters of your contest, you may choose to run Blue Ribbon reports, an Individual Student Report, or a Class Summary Report.
